Atlantic Ocean regions.




The road to ISLANDS

- GEF-7 \$515 million investment
- Approved by GEF Council: 13 June 2019
- Timeframe: July 2020 to July 2025
- 4 regions, 33 countries
- Programme launch June 2022 at Minamata COP4





ISLANDS Project Components




- 1. Preventing the future build-up of chemicals entering SIDS
- 2. Safe management and disposal of existing chemicals, products and materials
- 3. Safe management of products entering SIDS / Closing material and product loops for products
- 4. Facilitate SIDS-SIDS learning and sharing of knowledge.

Organigram








