Adaptation Practitioners Days December 1st – December 2nd, 2012

Adaptation Practitioners Days is a new interactive event that will bring together pioneers of adaptation to share experiences of climate-resilient development in action. The two-day event features presentations and films that showcase practical solutions for adaptation in Africa, the Middle East, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean.

Adaptation Practitioners Days addresses the question "what is adaptation in practice?" by bringing the experience of concrete adaptation actions from the field and by sharing lessons learned from more than 10 years of innovative adaptation financing through the Funds established under the UNFCCC – the Least Developed Countries Fund and the Special Climate Change Fund.

From the glacial lakes of Bhutan to the low-lying atolls of the Pacific, from combatting drought in Ethiopia to strengthening resilience to floods in Rwanda, Adaptation Practitioners Days explores a rich array of practices and technologies for adaptation, in different development sectors, and in different social and economic settings.

The Global Environmental Facility (GEF) will facilitate Adaptation Practitioners Days in collaboration with the Secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), and under the sponsorship of the Governments of Germany, the Gambia and Tuvalu.

This event will be held in conjunction with Development and Climate Days, facilitated by the Red Cross / Red Crescent Climate Centre (RCCC) and the International Institute for Environment and Development (IIED).
