ACCESSIBILITY OF THE WEB-BASED GEF PROJECT MANAGEMENT INFO SYSTEM

- Officially launched in December 2008 (access by GEF Secretariat And the GEF Evaluation Office only)
- Read-access granted to GEF Agencies and STAP (September 2009)

Direct access by STAP to provide STAP screen reports to Agencies (May 2010)

NPFE (National Portfolio Formulation Exercise)



WHAT IS THE GEF PMIS?



The **GEF PMIS** is a web-based database that can be read-accessed by GEF stakeholders anywhere in the world



The **GEF PMIS** provides reliable framework to exchange Project information between the Information Systems of the Secretariat, Trustee, GEF Agencies, the GEF Evaluation Office and the STAP



PMIS Access to Operational Focal Points

There are different levels of access based on the country of OFP and status of project.

Projects that belong to the same country as the OFP:

□ the OFP would have full read access to the project, including all documents.

Projects that do not belong to the same country as the OFP:

- ☐ if the project is approved, the OFP has full read-access to the project, including all documents
- ☐ if project is not approved, the OFP can only see the listing of the project but no details.
- ☐ if project is dropped before PIF approval/clearance, the OFP has full read access to the project, including all the documents
- OFP will be able to run all reports.




PMIS Access to Operational Focal Points

the OFP will have full read access to the project, including all documents




NEW PMIS WORKFLOW FOR PROJECT CONCEPTS






PMIS PROJECT CONCEPT LIST SCREEN for an OFP

Soon, the first screen for an Agency user after login to PMIS will be the "Concepts" screen. Here, you can print, view, accept or reject received project concepts.






PMIS PROJECT CONCEPT ENTRY SCREEN


