MEXICAN FEDERAL PROGRAMS ON ENERGY EFFICIENCY

The annual average growth of final energy consumption in Mexico has increased more than GDP¹. By maintaining current conditions on supply and consumption of energy, the Mexican energy sector will face serious complications to meet the energy needs of society in the future.

It is well known that of all clean energy sources, energy efficiency can provide the greatest impact at the lowest cost, hence the Mexican Government has combined efforts among federal institutions to implement lessons learned worldwide on **energy efficiency**.

The Mexican target is to transform the conventional local market in one of efficient technologies. It is necessary to promote best practices on energy use through energy efficiency activities and actions throughout all productive processes and final consumption, to reduce energy costs and to achieve a low carbon economy.

A technological improvement in energy efficiency in all economic sectors will enable economic growth, allow savings in energy bills, reduce energy intensity and promote sustainability as a climate change mitigation action.
