Summary

The Fifth Overall Performance Study of the Global Environment Facility has recently been completed by the GEF Independent Evaluation Office. This major study is conducted every four years and provides an independent assessment of the GEF. Its purpose is to assess the extent to which the GEF is achieving its objectives and to identify potential improvements. The results of the study have been presented and discussed at the replenishment meetings. The OPS5 report is available and provides a solid basis of work for GEF-6.

The study concluded that to fight against rapidly deteriorating environmental trends, the GEF needs to be strategic in its choices and achieve more with the resources at its disposal. It provides recommendations to update the business model and offers evidence of strong catalytic impact of GEF interventions.

The side event will provide an overview of the main conclusions and recommendations of OPS5 and key lessons learned regarding project design and implementation based on the portfolio analysis of GEF projects and impact evaluations that became a part of OPS5.
